



3. Small beach launching site 50 metres downstream from small car park off Riverside Dr. Just over 1 km up stream from Funnissdale (1). Reserve, picnic tables, toilets.
4. Riverview boat ramp, Birchley Rd, Coodanup. Picnic shelters, reserve.
5. Anabranch of Serpentine River.
6. Riverside Gardens Boat Ramp, Wanda Rd, Greenfields. Picnic shelters, bbq, reserve, boardwalk to lake upstream (600 m), river walk downstream (1.5km). Note: City of Mandurah has agreed to establish a beach launching site 100 m down stream from boat ramp.
7. All lakes and waterways up stream from Riverside Gardens are shallow to very shallow and suitable for canoeing only in winter and spring after good rains. May contain algae during warmer months.

1. Beach canoe-launching site 30m downstream of boat ramp, cnr Riverside Dr & Funnissdale Rd, Funnissdale
2. Small beach canoe-launching site 400m upstream of boat ramp, cnr Naim Rd and Bertram St, Coodanup

8. Rest/comfort site.
9. Rest/comfort site

Suggested Excursions:

Heron Trail

- From either 1 or 2 to 4 and return (3.5 kms)
- From 6 one way to either 1 or 2 (6.5 kms) or 3 (5.5 kms) with vehicle pick-up at destination.
- From 4 via 5 to 6 and return via river (11.5 kms). Note: Canoe 5 only after good rains.
- From 6 via 1 or 2 to 3 (The Mill) on Canoe Trail Guide 1 (Darter Trail). Return to 1 or 2 (11 kms) for vehicle pick-up.

Spoonbill Trail

- From 6 to 8 and return (12 kms).
- From 6 via 8 to 9 and return (17 kms). Note: Canoe only after good rains.
